

Jesus—the Bread of Life

John 6:22-70

Jesus teaches us that the Bread of life has five special qualities.

Special Quality 1: The Bread is Priceless.

Jesus is the Savior—Salvation is a gift received through faith in Him.

Special Quality 2: The Bread is Spiritual.

Jesus finally spells it out—“I am the bread of life.” (verse 35)

Special Quality 3: The Bread is Available.

Jesus tells us right here that ALL who come to Him will be accepted.

Do not be afraid that you are “unchosen” by God. If you are seeking after Him, He is available to you.

Special Quality 4: The Bread is Sufficient.

Jesus will meet you right where you are and He will be sufficient to meet your needs.

Special Quality 5: The Bread is Controversial.

Question: What about you today? Who do you say that Jesus is? Will you accept Jesus as the Bread of life or reject Him and go on your way?
