Loving Others Part I (Luke 10:25-37)— Everyone can improve their capacity to love their neighbor by learning to look in three directions...

Direction #1 Look in the mirror.

Look closely at what Jesus did with the man’s question—He turned it around. He doesn’t tell the man who his neighbor is—He shows the man how to be a neighbor.

Direction #2 Look in your own home.

Ephesians 5:21—“Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.” It’s a mutual submission—a give and take relationship.

Direction #3 Look at the big picture.

Our goal is not to act like a loving person, but to be a loving person!
