2. Provides hope. (Colossians 1:5)
3. Is a message of grace. (Colossians 1:6)
4. Is the hope of the world. (Colossians 1:6)

A Prisoner’s Prayer - Colossians 1:9-14

Two parts to Paul’s prayer:

1. Petition (Colossians 1:9)
2. Praise (Colossians 1:12)

Celebrating Jesus - Colossians 1:15-22
October 3, 2010

We should celebrate Jesus:

1. Because of Who He is. (Colossians 1:15-18)
2. Because of what He has done for us. (Colossians 1:19-22)

Living with Passion and Purpose - Colossians 1:24-2:3
October 10, 2010

We can live with passion and purpose when we are:

1. Willing to embrace suffering. (Colossians 1:24)
2. Living from a divine calling. (Colossians 1:25)
3. Proclaiming Christ. (Colossians 1:26-28)
4. Helping others know Christ and mature in Him.
(Colossians 1:28-2:3)

Believers Beware - Colossians 2:4-23
October 17, 2010

Here at CBC we will stay the course by avoiding the following errors:

1. Christless Philosophy (Colossians 2:8-15)
2. Legalism (Colossians 2:16-17)
3. Mysticism (Colossians 2:18, 19)
4. Asceticism (Colossians 2:20, 23)

Born Identity - Colossian 3:1-4
October 24, 2010

Born Identity: The Sequel - Colossians 3:5-14
October 31, 2010

If we are going to live from our new identity in Christ we must:

1. Put to death our earthly nature. (Colossians 3:5-9)
2. Put on the virtues of Christ. (Colossians 3:1-14)
