People who make a difference for Christ...

- 1. Walk with God, pray, watch and give thanks.
(Colossians 4:2)**

- 2. Pray for opportunities to proclaim Christ.
(Colossians 4:3-4)**

- 3. Are wise in their conduct with non-believers.
(Colossians 4:5)**

“To *walk in wisdom toward them that are without* (v. 5a) is to show practical Christian wisdom in dealing with non-Christians. The words suggest that the Christian is to exhibit caution and tact so that he will not needlessly antagonize nor further alienate his pagan neighbors. In a positive sense they may also suggest that the believer is so to conduct himself that his life will attract, impress, and convict the non-Christians around him.”
